- ◆ 不需詠唱其他彌撒曲

To: Parish Priests

Dear Reverend Father,

The celebration of public masses had been resumed last Sunday. The Diocese has received comments from lay Catholics of medical profession. They strongly advise that singing at Mass should be restricted since the pandemic is not yet stabilized.

Having discussed with Fr. Peter Choi, Chairman of Diocesan Sacred Music Commission, and with the approval of Cardinal John Tong, we make the following suggestions for your perusal:

- ◆ At the Entrance, all may either recite the Entrance Antiphon, or sing only two verses of an Entrance Hymn.
- ◆ Sing the Hallelujah. (Gospel Acclamation)
- ◆ Observe silence during the Offering of Gifts.
- ◆ Recite the Sanctus (Holy, holy, holy...).
- ◆ Sing The mystery of faith.
- ◆ All recite the Communion Antiphon together. Following silence, the Post-Communion Prayer is said.
- ◆ At the Recession, observe silence, or just sing two verses of a Recessional Hymn.
- ◆ No need to sing other songs or hymns during the Mass.
